Leipzig University Choir

In its more than 90-year history, the Leipzig University Choir has dedicated itself to ambitious choir literature and contemporary music from the very beginning. In addition to its passionate engagement concerning the work of Johann Sebastian Bach and historical performance practice, the choir also participated in scenic and concert opera productions and regularly performed large choral symphonic works from the 19th century as well as jazz literature. Invitations to national and international concert tours, such as to Spain, Latvia or Israel, as well as awards from renowned institutions like the "Echo Klassik", illustrate the artistic quality of the choir. About 90 passionate singers, all students and members of various disciplines from the University of Leipzig, are the current members of this traditional choir.
